- Lead : On-sight leading
- Speed : Tournament for the final round

(Competition will apply the UIAA COMPETITION ICE CLIMBING REGULATIONS 2018)

- Mandatory Equipments : Harness, Helmet (approved by UIAA), Ice-axes, Crampons, Climbing shoes and others

■ Prizes : Total 34,200 Euros

4 Transportation


■ To Cheongsong

1. In front of World Gate Bldg. in Incheon Airport International Business Center




To move from Incheon Int'l airport to World Gate Bldg., you should take free shuttle airport bus (At Bus stop No.12 on the 3rd floor, Incheon Int'l Airport to International Business Center). It takes 5 min.

2. Jamsil Sports Complex Station : Exit No.1 (Metro Line No.2 & 9)



Jamsil Sports Complex Station is on Metro line No.2 & 9. The bus will depart for Cheongsong in front of Exit No.1 of the station at 09:00 am.
(※KAF Staff will help your team at departure point.)

Note : Every participant should arrive at Departure Point by 08:40 am on 9th Feb.

- From Official Hotel to Competition Venue (10th ~ 11th Feb.)

- From Cheongsong
 1. To Seoul (11th Feb.)

- The nationality of each athlete will be decided as shown in his/her passport.

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
