UIAA CONDITIONS FOR YOUTH EVENTS (including Coaching)

1. Obligations of Participants

By applying for the Youth Event the participant acknowledges and accepts the rules of UIAA and commits him or herself to act according to these rules and procedures.

Participants applying for the Youth Event also acknowledge and accept that:

- In UIAA Ice Climbing Events they understand and abide by the rules of the sport and observe the principles of good sportsmanship;
- Treat other participants, officials and others involved in the practice of the sport with full and due respect at all times, both during and outside an event.
- Safety is a primary concern at Ice Climbing Events, but as with all the other forms of climbing there is a danger of personal injury or death;
- Participants at UIAA Ice climbing events accept the risks of participation and are responsible for their own actions which should take account of relevant circumstances such as changing weather and snow/ice conditions.
- To take part in Ice Climbing events it is necessary to be medically fit and have valid liability and accident insurance.
- The Coaching course fee is due if a participant has registered, even if he or she does not appear for the Coaching course.

2. Obligations of UIAA Member Associations (and Legal Guardians in the case on non-UIAA membership)

A Member Association whose participants apply for a Youth Event undertakes:

- To ensure participants (and or the parents or legal guardians of those under 18 years) are aware of, understand and accept their obligations and the risks and responsibilities of taking part in ice climbing events;
- To maintain an up-to-date list of contact details and addresses of holders of International Licenses and information on their training venues and to make these details available to UIAA. (N.B. the contact details of the Member Association are not acceptable as the contact details of the participant);
- that all applicants for a Youth Event have liability and accident insurance cover for ice climbing events and are medically fit to take part.

NOTES

1. Registration

Forms shall be sent **by Post, by E-mail or by Fax** duly dated by **14.01.10 the UIAA office**. Later applications, including at the event itself, will be possible, if places are still available. To qualify for the reduced charge, the form must be undersigned by Federation's Officer in charge and the Participant. Application forms with the seal and the signature of the applying Federation will be taken in priority to applications of non members. The decision of the UIAA regarding participation is final.

2. Authority:

An application form is compulsory for all official events.

3. Coaching course conditions

The Coaching courses are described in detail on the UIAA website. Participants will be informed on the Coaching course times per E-mail and published information at the event. The Coaching courses last 1,5 hours, but the participants should arrive 30 minutes before Coaching course begin for payment, distribution of equipment, etc.

4. Data Protection

The UIAA will only use the data from the Application for the purpose of events organisation and transmitting information on UIAA Ice climbing.
