- Team Quotas
 - Each National Federation : 8 male and 8 female competitors for each category
 - The Host Federation : 16 male and 16 female competitors for each category
 - The first 10 Women and Men listed on the World Ranking at the registration
deadline shall have a status of extra-quota competitors and can be registered
on top of the quota stated above. Any other supplementary participants need to
be approved by UIAA

Transportation

- Travel between Incheon airport and Seoul Youth Hostel : Up to each team's responsibility (There's an Airport Limousine bus No. 6015 to the walking-distance point from the hostel.)
- Travel between Seoul Youth Hostel and Cheongsong & During the stay at Cheongsong : Free shuttle bus
(* From Seoul to Cheongsong: Jan. 13, 9 am
* From Cheongsong to Seoul: Jan. 16, 9 am)

※**Very Important!** : Every participant should arrive at Seoul Youth Hostel by 10 p.m. on 12th at the latest.

Participation Fee

- Athletes : 190 Euro per person (Participation fee: €40, Accommodation & transportation fee: €150)
- Officials (Manager, Coach, etc) : €150 per person(for accommodation & transportation)
- €150 includes
 - Accommodation : 5 nights and 6 days from 12th Jan.(Thu) to 17th Jan.(Tue)
 - Meals : From lunch at 12th Jan.(Thu) to breakfast at 17th Jan.(Tue)
 - Domestic Transportation : All the domestic travel (except airport pickup) is provided. (Between Seoul and Cheongsong & during the stay at Cheongsong)
- Please pay in **cash only**.

Airfare support

- KAF will support airfare subsidies of €1,000 to the athletes who are world-ranked from 1st to 3rd. (Except Korean athletes, and if you're ranked in two disciplines, you're still paid €1,000.)
- To encourage more nations and athletes to participate, KAF will support airfare subsidies to each national team.
 - When a national team is from Asia(the UAAA member nations), €300 per person up to 3 athletes will be paid.
 - When a national team is from non-Asia, €500 per person up to 3 athletes will be paid.
 - 1st to 3rd World Ranked athletes are not counted for national airfare subsidies.
