Location

Plas y Brenin, National Mountaineering Centre, Snowdonia, N. Wales. This is a beautiful area with many rock types including limestone, mountain rock and slate. It is close to the highest mountain in England and Wales, Snowdon as well as many spectacular sea cliffs.

Accommodation Bunkhouse and campsite near Plas y Brenin. All participants bring their own tents, sleeping bags and mats.

Board Breakfast and dinner at Plas y Brenin Centre, lunch provided for all outdoor activities. Use of Plas y Brenin's facilities including climbing wall.

Programme 3 days climbing, bolted and traditional, 1 day multipitch in the mountains, 1-day mountain walking and 1-day multi-activity including canoeing. Cultural visit to slate quarries and Welsh castle.

Coaching Experienced qualified instructors used to climb with participants.

Participants: Ideal for young people aged 15- 22 who climb UIAA grade 4 and above with experience of mountain routes. We also invite participants to present some slides of the mountains where they live and their country. Children from all UIAA countries welcome.

Costs: £120 per participant for accommodation, programme and board.
