

# FAQs

## **What is the time and location of on-site registration?**

On-site registration begins at 14:00 CET and ends at 16:00 CET. It is on the first floor of the Cinéma nearby the Tourism Office of Champagny-en-Vanoise, Village. The UIAA must have received, or receive on-site, each athletes signed licence (under 18-year-olds need a signature of a legal guardian).

Registration fee is paid to the Organizer at the on-site registration. It is EUR 50 per athlete.

## **What do I need to know about accommodation and meals?**

The following is offered to the athletes at no cost:

- Dinner on February 9<sup>th</sup> and February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017 (Refuge du Bois)
- Breakfast on February 10<sup>th</sup> and February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017 (Refuge du Bois)
